

Things for Parents to know:

Therefore parents will be contacted in the case of illness, injury or homesickness at the discretion of the Menno Haven Staff. To preserve the quality of your child's experience at camp, Menno Haven does not have phone or email access for campers. Also, to help your child enjoy their week of camp, please do not send a cell phone.

Menno Haven Policy on Contacting your Child:

• In order to cut down on the amount of time and money spent processing and handling camper mail we would like everyone to abide by the following guidelines:

1. Please send all camper e-mail to mailbag@mennohaven.com
2. In the "subject" line, please put the campers **full name and cabin** see example
From: parent@yourhome.com
To: mailbag@mennohaven.com
Subject: Johnny Menno, Cabin Oak
3. Please limit to a maximum of one letter per day
4. Letters and Emails received after 12:00 noon will be handed out the next day. Mail received after 12:00 noon on Friday will not be handed out.
5. To help incorporate all campers, Cabins receiving mail for at least half of their campers will be allowed to spin the prize wheel or do some other silly thing, like singing.
6. We reserve the right to check all email for content unacceptable for a camp situation.
7. Please share these guidelines with Grandma, Grandpa, & the rest of the extended family.

- We expect children to attend the full week of camp. We strongly discourage the removal of your child early or during the middle of camp for other events.
- Leaving Camp affects your child, their cabinmates, the Head Cabin Counselor, and the entire program.

Cabin Assignments:

- As stated on the Registration Form, "Cabinmate requests for the first-year campers will be given priority. Other requests will be considered but not guaranteed. The cabinmate you select **MUST** also select you. **Limit One Request.**" Cabin assignments will be given as part of check-in on Sunday.

Photo CD's of the camp week are available for purchase at check-out. Thus NO money will be needed by campers while they are here (snacks and crafts are provided as part of the registration cost.)

For the safety of all campers, **all prescription and over-the-counter medications** must be turned in to the Camp Medical Provider during check-in. Please send sufficient medication for the duration of your child's stay in **original, labeled container**.

Any **deviations from the standards** laid out in this letter must be approved by the Program Director prior to arrival.
